1. Centuries before the events of this chapter, God made a promise concerning the boundaries of the promised land. To whom was that promise originally given and what were the boundary markers named at that time? (verses 1-2)

2. What would signify the southern and western borders? (verses 3-6)

3. What would signify the northern and eastern borders? (verses 7-12)

4. Why were the tribes of Reuben, Gad, and half of Manasseh to receive inheritance on the east side of the Jordan River? (verses 13-15)

5. Why were Eleazar the priest and Joshua commissioned to divide the land? What made them qualified for such an immense responsibility? (verses 16-17)

6. In addition to Eleazar and Joshua, who would aid in the land division process? (verses 18-29)
